**NO animals will be allowed to unload at the fairgrounds without previously having a health inspection (dated no more than 30 days prior to fair) on file in the Fair office. Any animal unloaded on the fairgrounds without meeting this requirement will be IMMEDIATELY dismissed from the grounds and DISQUALIFIED from participation.** Health inspections will be due in the fair office by July 21<sup>st</sup> at midnight. These forms may be faxed, emailed, mailed, or delivered in person. This ruling is required of EVERY animal to be brought on grounds including: horses, beef, sheep, goats, swine, rabbits, poultry, dogs, cats, as well as any pets for the children’s pet show. If you have extenuating circumstances with regards to the health inspection requirements, please contact the Fair Office.
