- Review all information on pages: 33-34, 57
- □ You must be signed up with 4-H or FFA in this project area/class in order to show your poultry
- If you are going to sell a 4-H animal through the Uinta County Jr. Livestock Sale, you must complete a Quality Assurance Training through 4-H o Meat pen of three poultry must be hatched after March 1st and owned by the exhibitor no later than May 15th
- Members must own and use their own poultry
- □ You must inform your 4-H Club Leader or FFA Advisor of a need for a pen for your poultry before Monday, July 15th
- Exhibitors must be signed up for Uinta County Fair ONLINE at: uinta.fairwire.org by Monday July 15th 11:59 p.m.
- □ You will need to sign up for each individual class you wish to show in (ie: meat pen of three broilers, 4-H/FFA Showmanship, etc.)
- □ You will receive an emailed receipt of all your entries. If you do not receive one, please contact the Fair Office to verify entries
- Weigh-ins for meat pen of three broilers will only be 11:00 AM Tuesday, July 30th at the rabbit/poultry barn scale
- □ Meat pen poultry must be a minimum weight of 3.5 pounds at weigh-ins
- Poultry showmanship will begin at 10:00 AM Wednesday, July 31st with meat pen of three immediately following
- You must secure a bill of sale on your market animal to submit during weigh-ins Tuesday, August 1st
- A Junior Livestock Sale Declaration form must be completed, signed by both the exhibitor and a parent, and returned to the Fair Office by 5:00 PM Thursday, August 1st. All animals must be fed and bedded following the sale Friday, August 2nd
- □ All poultry must remain on grounds until exhibit release time at 4:00 PM Saturday, August 3rd
- All exhibitors must check with Livestock Sale Committee before leaving Saturday, August 3rd to ensure none of your animals will be left on grounds following Fair. All pens must be completely cleaned out Saturday, August 3rd prior to leaving the Fairgrounds
